O R D E R

In a prior appeal, the Court of Appeals for the Eleventh Circuit reversed George High's conviction with respect to Count Thirteen of the indictment and remanded for a retrial on that count. The government subsequently dismissed that count. Pursuant to the opinion of the Eleventh Circuit dated August 7, 2001, the special assessment imposed by the court on that count is rescinded. Since Virginia High was convicted on six counts other than Count Thirteen, the court hereby imposes a special assessment in the total amount of \$300. The government is directed to refund any money paid by Virginia High with respect to the special assessment imposed pursuant to her conviction on Count Thirteen.
