

**DeKalb DA widens probe of police shootings    cbs 46.com**

**DECATUR, Ga. (AP)** -- The district attorney in DeKalb County has widened a grand jury review of police shootings last year to add shootings in which other law enforcement agencies -- including Atlanta police and federal marshals -- killed suspects in DeKalb County. DA's office spokeswoman Andora Andy says DeKalb County police and other agencies have provided records of their investigations to District Attorney Gwin Keyes Fleming. But Andy said yesterday there is no timetable for when Keyes Fleming will ask the county's Superior Court judges to empanel a special grand jury to look at the cases. She also would not specify what the district attorney is looking for as it investigates the shootings. The grand jury review comes after DeKalb County police killed 12 suspects last year -- the most in the metro Atlanta area.

The DeKalb County Police Department asked the DA to review its investigation of the shootings after civil rights activists and suspects' relatives staged public protests. *(Copyright 2007 by The Associated Press. All Rights Reserved.)*
