Complaint: 1st Amendment Rights Violated by 2 Marshall's & 5 Federal Police

Below is an accurate copy of a protest sign I carried on 6/26/07 at the Richard B. Russell Building. I was on the sidewalk on the south side of the courthouse on Mitchell St. I arrived at 12:30 p.m. and about 12:45, 2 U.S. Marshall's came out and told me that I had to leave because I could not protest on federal property. I refused to leave and told them that I had the right to protest under the 1st amendment and I told them that the sidewalk was not federal property. They went back inside and about 1:00 p.m. Attorney William Morrison, named below and who I had not seen since 1994 went into the courthouse after seeing me and the sign and I called his name "very loudly" from about 30-40 ft. William Morrison never looked my way and when he got to the entrance, I saw him speak to a marshal and he pointed my way. 10 minutes later, the same 2 Marshall's came back out and asked me if I had a permit to protest and I said "no". He then said "you have to leave now" and get a permit from the General Service Administration before you can protest. I refused to leave and told him that or they would call the federal police and have me arrested. I told them that I would not leave, so call the police. They called the police and I continued to hold up my protest sign. One of them asked me for my drivers license and I refused and told him that he could find everything on my website. After about 15-20 minutes 2 federal police cars arrived and two police got out of each car. At that point I was surrounded by 5 federal police and 2 Marshall's and an about 5-6 citizens stopped to see what was going on. One police approached me, very close and told me if I did not leave now he would arrest and I told him to arrest me because I was not leaving because I was not on federal property, but a public sidewalk and had a right to petition there, just as people do at the white house, the Supreme Ct. and every court in the United States as long as they don't block the entrance. A few more people had stopped because the police was talking loud and so was I. The police stepped in the street and walked beyond the 1st lane, where their cars were parked and said: "the federal property extends past the 1st lane." The police looked at the people that had stopped to see what was going on and said Mr. High I do not want to arrest you, but the **federal law says that anyone who protest on federal property must first get a permit from the General Service Administration**, so first put down your sign and go to the 2nd floor and make application for a permit stating what day and time you want to protest. The 5 police and 2 Marshall's was not backing down and the people was not leaving and I was still holding up my sign. The main police asked me what time had I planned to leave and I said 2:00, and I asked him what time was it and he said 1:45. He said that he had no problem with me staying 15 more minutes if I agreed to get a permit from the G.S.A. before I protest again, and if. The marshals agree and the Marshall's said "No" and they wanted me to leave now or they would arrest me. I left at that point to avoid any confrontation.
